Terrain of the ranch consists of the main low lying draw that runs north and south through the ranch to some more rugged hills that hold lots of winter feed on the sides and in the lower pockets and drainages. On the east side of the ranch is the Cornucopia range which is where this ranch gets its name. To the north sits the Guadalupe Mountains providing a picturesque backdrop. Grasses consist of Blue and Black Gramma, Side Oats, Buffalo, Tabosa and Brush Muley. There is some areas of brush in the lower areas providing good cover for the native wildlife. Hunting consists of Mule deer, Barbary sheep, Oryx, Quail, Dove and the normal varmints associated with SE New Mexico ranches. This ranch is diverse in many ways and provide a great opportunity to operate a high desert ranch with majestic views.
